Foreword.

The Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India under sub section (1) of section 24 of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005(42 of 2005) in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India framed the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Audit of schemes Rules, 2011.

Under Rule 4 of the aforesaid Rules, the State Government constituted an independent Society known as "Meghalaya Society for Social Audit & Transparency" in short MSSAT.

The Society was registered under the Meghalaya Society Registration Act, XII of 1983 on 25th February 2015 vide NO.SR/MSSAT-03/15 of 2015.

The Governing Body held on the 22nd March 2016 resolved that social audit for the year 2016-17 should be conducted atleast 50% of the VECs in each Block, incurring the highest expenditure on MGNREGA schemes. The list of 50% of the VECs incurring the highest expenditure on MGNREGA schemes was collected from all the Blocks and 3135 VECs (i.e.51%) were audited during 2016-17 accordingly.

OBSERVATIONS / SUGGESTIONS ON THE SOCIAL AUDIT REPORTS CONDUCTED DURING 2016-17 ON MGNREGA SCHEMES AND IAY SCHEMES SANCTIONED DURING 2014-15.

1. Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act.

A. Delay in payment of wages:

Social Audit was conducted in 3135 VECs during 2016-17 out of which there was delay in payment of wages to 832 VECs, that is, about 26.54%. The name of the 832 VECs are mentioned in the report at paragraphs 1.A.1, 1.B.1, 2.A.2, 2.B.1, 2.C.1, 3.A.1, 3.B.1, 3.C.1, 3.D.1, 3.E.1, 3.G.1, 4.A.1, 4.B.1, 4.C.1, 5.A.1, 5.B.1, 5.C.1, 5.D.1, 6.A.1, 6.B.1, 9.C.1, 10.A.1, 10.B.1, 11.D.1.

The Act provides payment of compensation @0.05% of the unpaid wages per day of delay beyond the sixteenth day of closure of muster roll.

There are only 2 (two) exceptions where compensation is not payable, that is,

- (a) Compensation is not due, and
- (b) Natural calamities.

The implementing agency may take step to ensure timely payment of wages as laid down in the Act to avoid unnecessary payment of compensation for the delay by the State Government.

B. Maintenance of Records:

Out of 3135 VECs where social audit was conducted during 2016-17, 73 VECs did not maintained any register/record at all and 680 VECs did not maintained the records / registers properly as mentioned at paragraphs 1.A.2, 1.B.2, 2.A.3, 2.C.3, 3.A.2, 3.B.2, 3.C.2, 3.D.2, 3.F.1, 3.H.1, 4.A.2, 4.B.2, 4.C.2, 5.A.2, 5.B.2, 5.C.2, 5.D.2, 6.A.2, 6.B.2, 8.C.1, 10.A.2, 10.B.2, 11.B.2, 11.C.1. That is, 21.69% of the VECs audited did not maintain records properly and 2.33% were implementing the schemes without maintenance of any record / register.

It is needless to mention about the importance of maintenance of records in all schemes implemented by any department as this is well laiddown rules of the

Government. However it is found that 2.33% of the VECs audited have not maintained any register at all and 21.69% were not maintain the records properly.

Non maintenance of registers by the VECs in a proper form/format is as good as non maintenance of register and this is in violation of para 20 of the schedule II of the Act read with section 23(2) of the Act.

It is suggested that compulsory training to all the VEC's office bearers be provided within the month of May every year since social audit will normally start from the month of June onwards. Programme Oficer should depute his officers to verify that all VECs are maintening the registers as per format of the Ministry.

C. Non maintenance of citizen information board:

Out of 3135 VECs audited, 184 VECs, (about 5.87%) have not erected citizen information board as provided in the Act. The names of the VECs without citizen information board have been mentioned at paragraphs 1.A.3, 1.B.3, 3.A.3, 3.B.3, 3.D.4, 4.C.4, 5.D.3, 8.A.1 and 11.B.1 of the reports.

Non display of information of the programme amounts to violation of para 2.9.6, 2.9.7.5 and 2.9.7.7 of the Master Circular (FY 2016-2017) issued by the Ministry of Rural Development read with Section 23(3) and para 25(a) Schedule I of the Act. Para 2.9.8 of the Master Circular (FY 2016-2017) issued by the Ministry of Rural Development read as follows: - "Violations of any of the above provisions will be considered as an offence under the Mahatma Gandhi NREGA, thereby attracting the provisions of Section 25 of the Act."

D. Non availability of work site facilities:

Out of 3135 VECs audited, 233 VECs (i.e about 7.43%) were not provided with work site facilities. The name of the VECs without worksite facilities are mentioned at paragraphs 1.A.4, 1.B.4, 3.A.3, 3.B.4, 3.D.3, 3.G.2, 3.H.2, 4.B.3, 6.A.4 and 6.B.4 of the reports.

The implementing agency is suppose to provide Worksite facilities (Medical aid, drinking water and shade) at the worksite as mentioned at para 27 of Schedule II of the Act and para 7.12 of the Operational Guidelines, 2013 issued by the Ministry of Rural Development. It is however detected that such facilities have not been provided to 7.43% of the VECs audited.

Violation of any of the provision of the Act invite penalty as laid down under Section 25 of the Act.

E. Number of Jobcards in the VECs not tally with the number of jobcards in the MIS:

The Jobcards verified at site does not tally with the number of jobcards entered into the MIS. The number of jobcards in 111 VECs out of 3135 VECs audited, does not tally with the MIS which is about 3.54%. The name of the VECs where the number of jobcards does not tally with the MIS are mentioned at paragraphs 1.A.5, 1.B.7, 4.B.4, 4.C.3, 5.B.4 and 5.C.4 of the reports.

The Programme Officer should verify the actual number of jobcards in each VEC and take step to update the MIS accordingly.

F. Jobcards not available with the Jobcard holders:

Jobcards are not available with the Jobcard holders in the 5 VECs mentioned at paragraphs 1.A.8, 5.B.3, 5.C.3 and 5.D.4 of the reports.

Verification and updating of Jobcards by Block office or VECs should be done immediately and return to the Jobcard holders. Jobcards should be kept with the Jobcard holders especially during the conduct of social audit so that the same could be verified during house to house visit.

G. Work not provided to job seekers:

Jobcard holders of 2(two) VECs reported that they were not provided the work after demand in the VECs as mentioned at paragraphs 2.A.5 and 2.B.2 of the reports. During the public hearing the APO clarified that the demand was made verbally and field inspection had to be conducted first.

Para 2.2.1.2 of the Master Circular (FY 2016-2017) issued by the Minstry of Rural Development reads as follow: - "The implementing agencies must ensure that

workers in need of employment under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA are provided work within 15 days of the receipt of the application or the date of demand, in case of advance application, whichever is later, as mandated by the Act. Program Officer and implementing agencies must ensure that work is provided on demand within 15 days."

Non sanction of work within 15 days is in violation of para 6 of Schedule II of the Act and Ministry's circular.

H. VEC refused to conduct social audit:

2(two) VECs refused to conduct social audit as mentioned at paragraphs 1.B.6 and 7.A.1 of the reports.

Conduct of social audit is part of the Act and refusal of the VEC to conduct social audit amount to violation of the Act and action may be taken under Section 25 of the Act.

I. Painting not available on completed projects:

Painting (Black and Yellow) on the completed schemes were not available in 35 VECs as mentioned at paragraph 2.C.5 of the reports.

J. Surviving rate of plants:

Surviving rate of bamboo plant is very less as mentioned at paragraph 1.B.9 of the report as the sapling was supplied during winter.

1.A.3. Worksite Board is available at the worksite in <u>Chiehruphi VEC</u> however, thers is still no signboard <u>in Kairang & Suchen Lumiarain VEC</u>

1.A.4. The <u>3 nos. of</u> VECs have received their worksite facilities.

1.A.5. Difference in JC Nos. from the MIS and at 40 nos. of VECs was clarified that the difference is due to the changes made in the MIS from AEC to VEC.

1.A.6. At <u>Lad lakadong VEC-</u>The Secretaryy clarified that HH=27 while JC=44 because the children live in same house but they do not share a common kitchen hence, they got separate Job Card.

1.A.7. The BDO has clarified that <u>Sakhri</u> cannot be a separate VEC because it is not a census village

1.A.8. The Secretary of <u>Tuber Shohshrieh VEC</u> told that the JCs are at the Block office for verification and Scanning.

1.A.9. The Secretary of <u>Suchen Lumiarain</u> VEC clarified that they will continue the work again since the estimate is with the chairman so they dont know how much work should be done.

Action Taken:
